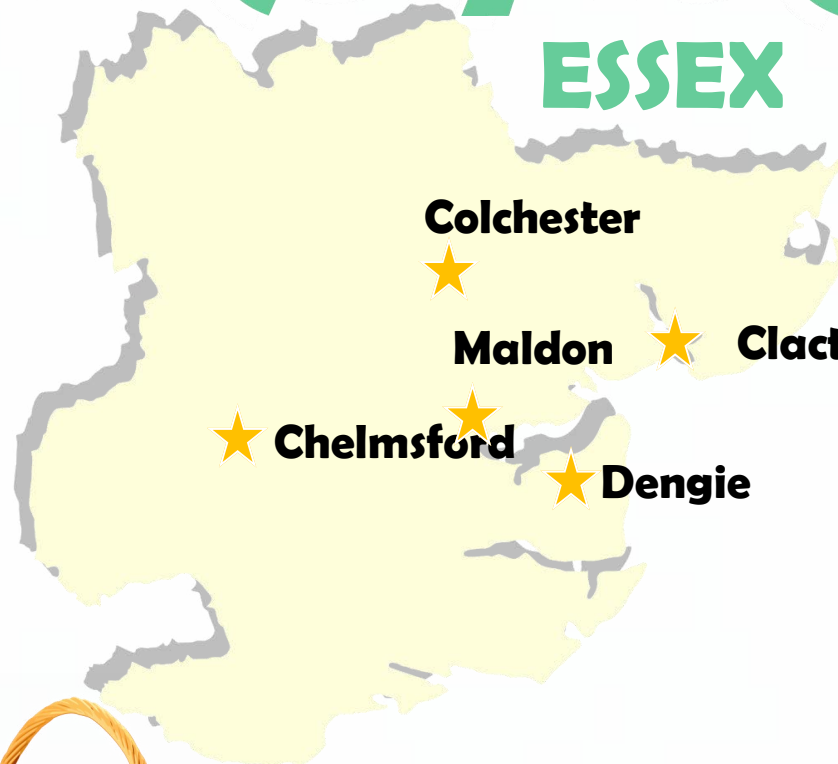

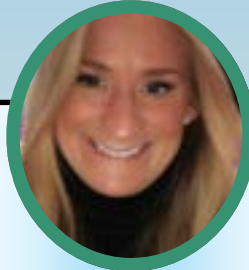

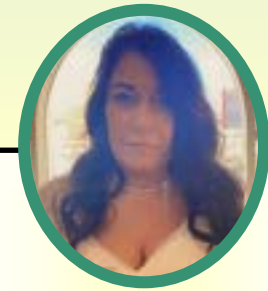

- have a diagnosis of special educational needs and/or a physical disability
- live within the administrative boundaries of Essex County Council (excluding Southend and Thurrock)
